

**ALL SCOUTS MUST REGISTER WITH NATIONAL FOR THE JAMBOREE
WHEN A SCOUT REGISTERS, HE WILL THEN RECEIVE HIS BAR-CODED MEDICAL FORM**

The following is a link from National that instructs Jamboree participants step-by-step on how to Register with National for the Jamboree:

You must register on-line from the MyScouting.org website, so, you have to have an Account on MyScouting.org to access the registration process on the website.

The link above instructs the Jamboree participants (Scouts, Scoutmasters and Staff) on:

1. How to open an account on MyScouting.org (for those who may not already have one)

And then immediately leads you into the process to....

2. Register with National for the Jamboree

The process to register on-line for the Jamboree is very straightforward. However, some additional information may be helpful:

1. Have your scout's BSA membership number handy before you begin the process. This number can be found on your scout's Boy Scout membership card or ask the Scoutmaster for the number.
2. Be prepared to pay a \$10.00 Processing Fee with a credit card at the end of the registration process.
3. You can print out the Registration Confirmation when you complete the registration and you will receive another copy via email shortly thereafter.
4. The required "\$100.00 initial deposit" stated in the Registration Confirmation was already paid when you paid their initial \$300 deposit. You do NOT need to pay it.
5. You will need to have your Home Troop Scoutmaster sign the Registration Confirmation and then you turn it in at the Council Office. Please contact James Caudill and let him know when you have submitted this paperwork to the Council Office: southern@lds.net or Cell 714-323-6694.
6. The National Registration process must be completed before the Bar-coded Medical Forms will be emailed to you.

Tips: To help avoid the possibility of the email with the Bar-coded Medical Form getting lost, accidentally deleted, or going into a Spam or Junk folder:

1. When the Registration process asks you to enter your email address, enter your Primary Email address and not your son's. The email address you list will be the one that National will use to send you the Registration Confirmation and two emails: One is your Bar-coded Medical Form, and the other is your Password to access the Bar-coded Medical Form.
2. To minimize the possibility of these two important e-mails going into your Spam or Junk Folders, include the National (Medical) Email Address jamboree.medical@scouting.org in your "Approved Senders File" or "Contact File".
3. Just to be safe, check your Spam and Junk mail folders periodically for these e-mails.

Each Troop 812 Scout must be registered with National in order to receive the Bar-coded Medical Form. Scout leaders encourage all families to please do this now. Thank you.
